Chris will be here in Perth on Monday 18th October 2010 speaking at the Perth Function Centre, Lathlain.

Chris Paton is a professional genealogist and regular contributor to several family history publications, including *Your Family History*; *Practical Family History*; *Family History Monthly*; and *Discover my Past Scotland*.

Formerly a BBC television producer, he holds a Postgraduate Diploma in Genealogical Studies and runs the Scotland's Greatest Story ancestral research service (www.ScotlandsGreatestStory.co.uk). He also teaches online Scottish courses through Pharos Teaching and Tutoring Ltd (www.pharostutors.com).
